REQUEST FOR SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Diversifying energy resources is a key objective of the Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resources (MEMR) in Jordan, as outlined in its strategic plan for 2025–2035. One of the primary goals of this plan is to expand the utilization of natural gas as a major energy source across all sectors.

The Natural Gas Distribution Networks Project aims to provide low-cost gas supplies to customers in Amman and Zarqa. The Project includes the development of a distribution pipeline network to be connected to existing infrastructure that will supply households, businesses, hotels, light industries and the transportation sector in Amman and Zarqa.

MEMR is now inviting interested organizations with relevant experience and expertise (Applicants) to submit Letters of Interest (LOI) indicating their suitability for the Project. This request for LOIs is the first stage of the formal process for the selection of an entity to develop the Natural Gas Distribution Network in Amman and Zarqa. The next stage of the formal process will be confirmed following the conclusion of the LOI stage.

This request for LOIs is available on the webpage of MEMR: www.memr.gov.jo. It is compulsory to submit the LOI in accordance with the requirements of this request for LOIs.

Requirements

In addition to confirmation of their interest in participating in the formal selection process, Applicants are requested to provide a summary statement on their qualifications and

- **Applicant structure:** Applicants are requested to confirm their proposed organizational structure. (Applicants may be either a single business entity or joint ventures, consortia, partnerships or other combinations of business entities composed of members (local and/or international). Applicants are not bound to retain their proposed structure at the next stage of the formal selection process.)
- **Contact information:** The Applicant's contact data shall include:
 - Applicant Name and Contact Person
 - Address, telephone number and email address

MEMR will send any clarifications and addenda concerning this request for LOIs and the next stage of the formal process to the Contact Person listed above. The Applicant is required to confirm receipt of any e-mail from the Contracting Authority (MEMR) as soon as possible. Applicants composed of more than one member should select a single point of contact.

- **Experience:** Applicants are requested to provide an overview of their applicable credentials and examples of experience relevant to the development of natural gas distribution networks.
- **Financial standing:** Applicants are requested to confirm that they have had a positive net operating income over the last three-year period. (Where Applicants are composed of more than one member, all members should confirm this.)
- **Legal compliance:** Applicants should confirm their commitment to abide by all applicable laws, bylaws and regulations in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

Please also note the following:

- MEMR will not reimburse any costs incurred by the interested parties in preparing and submitting the LOI. The interested party shall incur all such costs.
